Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ): 1. What is a FQHC? - A Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) strives to help meet the needs of an underserved area or population. As a nonprofit and tax-exempt organization, a FQHC can receive grants from the government, the private sector, and donations in addition to Medicare and Medicaid funding. 2. Are we a free clinic? – No we are not a free clinic. However we do provide a sliding fee scale. It is a discount payment model we use to care for patients who cannot afford care or lack private insurance. The amount discounted is based on your proven income. 3. What is Gulf Coast Health Center afterhours access available after 8PM? – After closing, we have on call providers available to speak with you if you have any questions or concerns. To speak with them, call the main phone number (877) 983 1161 to speak with a phone operator to be forwarded to provider. 4. What is Evidence Based Care (EBC) - an approach to medical practice intended to optimize decision-making by emphasizing the use of evidence from well designed and conducted research. 5. What is Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH)? – a model of care where patients have a direct relationship with a provider who coordinates a cooperative team of healthcare professionals. Primary care that is oriented towards the whole person. Research shows that PCMHs improve quality and the patient experience, and increase staff satisfaction—while reducing health care costs.
