Frequently Asked Questions:

- 1. What is a FQHC? A Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) strives to help meet the needs of an underserved area or population. As a **nonprofit** and tax-exempt organization, a FQHC can receive grants from the government, the private sector, and donations in addition to Medicare and Medicaid funding.
- 2. Are we a free clinic? No we are not a free clinic. However we do provide a sliding fee scale. It is a discount payment model we use to care for patients who cannot afford care or lack private insurance. The amount discounted is based on your proven income.
- 3. Are there Providers available after workhours (After 8PM)? After closing, there are no providers available to physically see you. However, we do have on call providers available to speak with you if you have any questions or concerns. To speak with them, call the main phone number (409) 983 1161 to speak with a phone operator. They will then forward you to a waiting provider.
- 4. Does Gulf Coast Health Center accept Private Insurance, Medicare, and Medicaid? Gulf Coast Health Center accepts all patients, whether you have private insurance, Medicaid, Medicare or self pay (no insurance).
- 5. What information is needed for me to see a provider? Patients will need to provide a copy of their Driver's License, proof of income and/or insurance card.
- **6.** Are my medications free? Gulf Coast Health Center medications are at a discounted rate. We offer programs that patients may qualify for that cover prescription cost.
- 7. What is Evidence Based Care (EBC) An approach to medical practice intended to optimize decision-making by emphasizing the use of evidence from well designed and conducted research.
- 8. What is Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH)? A model of care where patients have a direct relationship with a provider who coordinates a cooperative team of healthcare professionals. This primary care is oriented towards the whole person. Research shows that PCMHs improve quality and patient experience, and increase staff satisfaction while reducing health care costs.
